This is a great activity for all the family (under 18s must be accompanied and supervised). Please wear stout shoes and long sleeves and trousers (to avoid nettle stings), gloves will be provided.

Meet at the car park beside the Canal Arm, Melbourne, YO42 4QJ. Park in the village and walk down the lane beside the Melbourne Arms pub.
